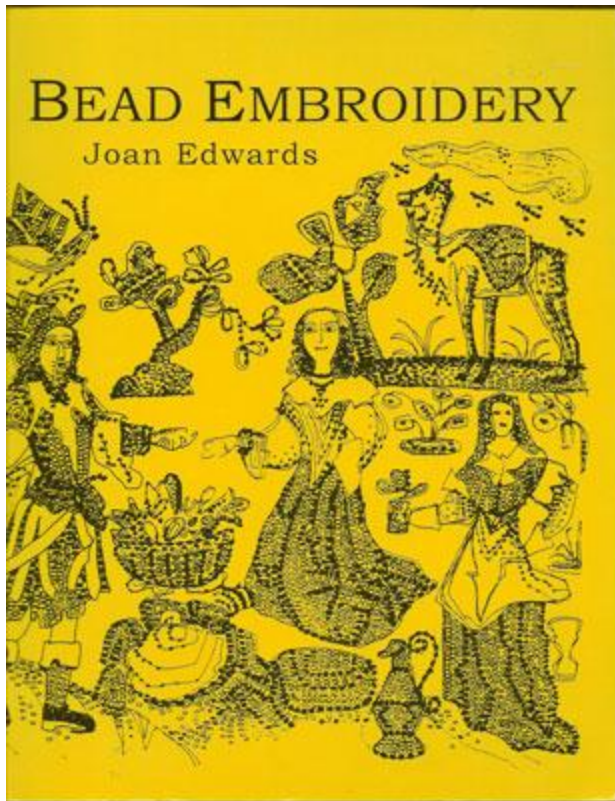


Bead Embroidery Joan Edwards \$27.50 950-117



This scholarly reprint is of beads in their association with textiles -- suggestions and information on how they were used, where and what their first uses were. And they were in use long before the Ice Age. The author gives general information on needle and tambour beading, wire beading, edgings and trims, crochet, knitted and tatted beading and weaving on a bead loom for which she provides directions for making. Profusely illustrated with black and white drawings, a source of unusual inspiration and design planning. Extensive bibliography.

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
