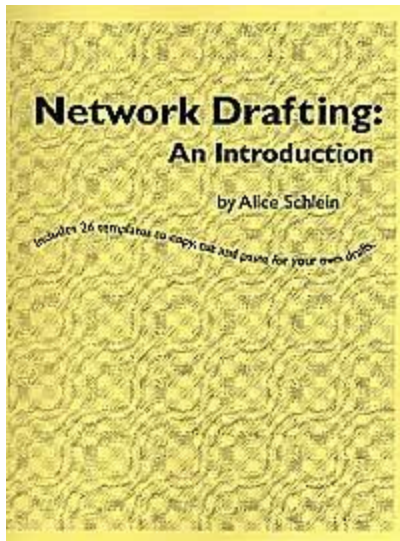


Network Drafting
