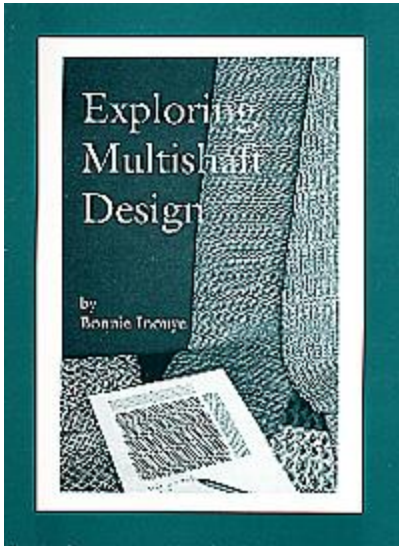


Exploring Multishaft Design

You know that other branch of the jacquard looms the dobbie looms many weavers use today? This exploration melds these elements into a new study for the advanced multi-shaft weaver. The simple threadings and intricate treadlings and tie-ups that computers and dobbie looms allows us to explore are the foundations of this study. Dazzling twill structures, double-weaves, and spot weaves are the starting point. Dobbie looms and computers are tools in this study, but the section on developing these ideas for standard multi-shaft looms makes this a remarkable textbook for multi-shaft weavers.

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
